Type 2 diabetes represents about 90 to 95 percent of all cases of diabetes diagnosed. Up to 80 percent of people living with type 2 diabetes are overweight.

It's estimated that as many as 40 percent of adults in the United States have pre-diabetes, and it's on the rise among adolescents and even younger children. Those with pre-diabetes are at high risk for developing type 2 diabetes within 10 years.
